## **Acceptable Forms of Proof**

## **Proof of legal Indiana Residency**

All Documents Must be CURRENT and VALID \*Temporary (or paper) IDs are not accepted\*

- Government issued Driver's License/ Real State I.D. (Front and Back Required)
  OR
- Two (2) of the following forms (as per the Indiana BMV requirements):
  - U.S. Postal Service change of address confirmation.
  - An Indiana voter registration card.
  - Survey of your Indiana property.
  - Utility company, credit card, doctor, or hospital bill issued within 60 days of application.
  - o Residence mortgage or similar loan contract, lease or rental contract, or land deed.
  - o Bank statement or bank transaction receipt, dated within 60 days of application.
  - Current motor vehicle loan payment book.
  - Valid homeowner's, renters, or car insurance policy dated within one year of application or Buggy registration (Amish population).
  - W-2 Form, property tax, excise tax bill or Social Security Administration or other pension or retirement annual benefit summary statement, dated within current or immediately prior year.
  - Pre-printed pay stub, dated within 60 days of application.
  - o Indiana Department of Child Services child support. check stub. Medicaid or Medicare benefit statement dated within 60 days of application.
  - o Valid Indiana handgun permit.
  - o First-class mail from any federal or state court or agency, dated within 60 days of application.
  - o Public or private school records indicating an enrolled student's name and residence address.
  - Valid and active ID card issued pursuant to the Indiana Attorney.

## Proof of Lawful Presence in the United States

All Documents Must be CURRENT and VALID \*Temporary (or paper) IDs are not accepted\*

- One (1) of the following forms (as per the Indiana BMV requirements):
  - Original or certified copy of a birth certificate filed with a U.S. state or territory office of vital statistics or equivalent agency in your state of birth.
  - Unexpired U.S. Passport or U.S. Passport Card.
  - Consular Report of Birth Abroad (CRBA) issued by U.S. Department of State: Forms FS-240, DS-1350 or FS-545.
  - o Certificate of Citizenship: Forms N-560 or N-561.
  - Certificate of Naturalization issued by DHS: Forms N-550 or N-570.
  - Unexpired Permanent Resident Card: Form 1-551.
  - Unexpired foreign passport in your name with English subtitles or translation, with an unexpired U.S. Visa and an approved 1-94.
  - Unexpired foreign passport without a U.S. Visa if your authorized admittance and lawful status can be verified by DHS.
  - Unexpired Employment Authorization Card: Form 1-766.
  - o Proof of application for asylum in the U.S.: Form 1-589.
  - 1-797 Notice of Action received by DHS and accompanied by other U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) documents.
  - o Other USCIS lawful status documents that can be used to verify lawful status with DHS.
